❖ A \$20.00 donation to the USBGF gives you the right to compete in the U.S. Online Playoffs by placing higher than other donors in the events that are preceded by the “❖” symbol. The donation is required for each-qualifying event or re-entry. How high one has to place to gain a seat in the Playoffs depends on the number of donors in each event and the total number of players in the event including non-donors as is indicated in the panel to the right.

If THERE ARE:

- 1-31 players in an event which may include donors and non-donors, only the donor who goes the furthest in the event will qualify;
- 32-63 players, then first and second donors going furthest will qualify;
- 64-95 then a third player will qualify;
- 96-127 adds a 4th player;
- 128 -159 adds a 5th player, and so on

If DONORS TIE for the same place, all that tie will gain seats in the U.S. Online Playoffs.

If RE-ENTRIES are permitted as part of a tournament, each player will only be counted once to determine the number of qualifiers selected for the U.S. Online Playoffs.

Additional REQUIREMENTS

- U. S. Citizenship
- Must be USBGF Premium/Youth member
- Must be willing to play in proctored online matches in both the U.S. Online Playoffs and the International Championship
- All matches in Playoffs and International Championship will be recorded

Stipulation

The entry fee of 1000 Euros plus 50 Euros for registration for each of four seats in the 1st International Backgammon Championship will be paid by the USBGF.

**1ST INTERNATIONAL BACKGAMMON
Championship Schedule**

- Each country will use a competitive process to select 1-4 individual players by October 10th, 2011
- The U.S. Playoffs will take place between September 5th and October 10th, 2011
- The International Competition will begin on October 12, 2011 and continue until the end of December, 2011
- Semi-final and Final rounds may be held as a live event in a country to be determined by competitive bids from prospective sponsors, tentatively scheduled during the first quarter of 2012
